Introduction

Our knowledge of this family came from Rodney Lee Jeffcote of Derbyshire. He had done a limited amount of research into this family and we are reproducing his work as he sent it to us, with some additions of our own taken from some of our material.

The family tree starts with William Jeffcote who, it is believed, was a tenant farmer of the Newdigate family of Arbury Hall, Astley, near Nuneaton.

A link with family CZ is possible [There is a link.]. Clearly, more research is required.

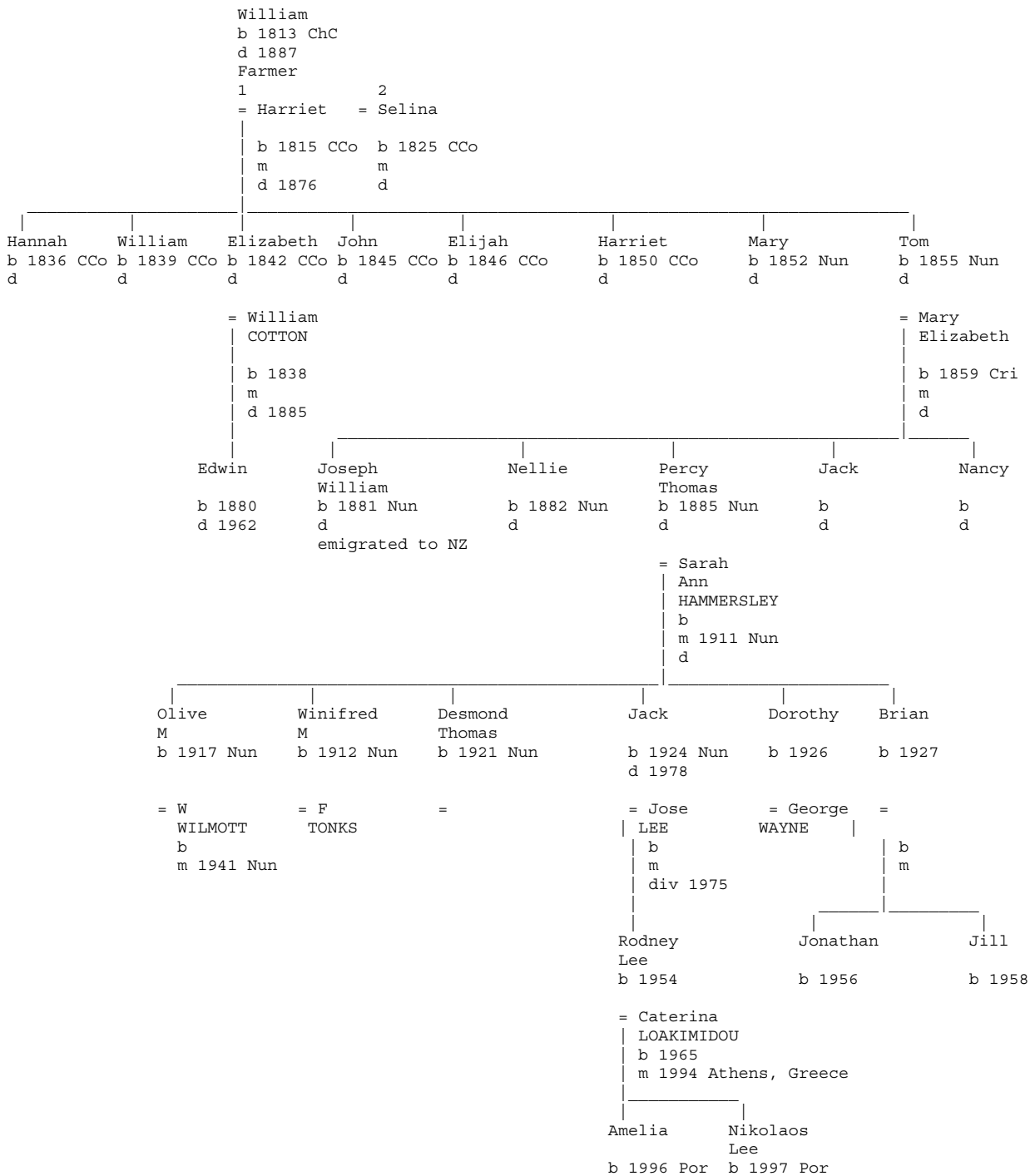
The 1881 census tells us that he was a police constable. We could not find him in the 1891, 1901 or 1911 censuses.

Introduction

My knowledge of this family came from Dot Jeffcott of Rugby. She wrote to me in 1994 and gave me information about what she knew of her family history. What little is known is shown on the family tree detailed overleaf.

Dot said that her father, George Hammond Jeffcott, was born in 1918, although no birth appears in the births index at the GRO. There is a George H Jeffcott registered in 1914, with the mother's maiden name as Fulleylove. If this is correct, there were other children of the marriage. This requires checking.

The 1881 census shows the family living in the household of William Allen in Sutton Coldfield, which is presumably the maiden name of Catherine, the children's mother.

Family folklore has it that there were Jeffcott links with Nuneaton, but that an argument led to a lack of contact with that side of the family.

By 2020, we had expanded this family tree by a good amount and confirmed the Fulleylove connection.
