#### Introduction

#### The Family Tree Collection

This section of the book is probably of greatest interest to people as it is here that the family tree information, that has been collected from various sources, is to be found. Most of it has been researched extensively, but unfortunately, the research stops when there is a lack of records, or records are difficult to access. That is why we have so many family branches that cannot be joined together, many of them seemingly starting in the 18<sup>th</sup> century. In those days, if we are lucky we will find a baptism and a burial; a marriage too if one took place. Once we come into the 19<sup>th</sup> century, things get a lot more interesting.

In the miscellaneous reference section towards the end of the book, may be found other, un-researched references which you may recognise as belonging to a family that you are seeking.

Since publishing the first edition of this book, some of the family tree codes (see below) have disappeared, to be added to other family trees, where a link has been proved. It is highly probable that most of the family trees are linked to the already much researched lines of AA, AK, AR, BR, BW, etc. We already have a link between AA and AB, but this has been left as it is, as two family lines, with a common progenitor.

In this section is to be found, possibly, some inaccurate information, as it contains names of persons and other details that have been provided, in good faith, from personal recollections of individuals, often passed on by word of mouth. Please remember that one should always check one's facts before moving on to the next stage of research.

### The Family Coding System

When we first started our research in the 1980s, we derived a code system to enable us to identify the various people that we found in records. Jess Arthur Jephcott's family were coded 'A', Sue McBeth and Bob Jephcott's (for want of a better letter) were coded 'B', June and Archie Jephcott's were coded 'K' for Kilsby, which seemed fitting at the time. When we started to get ambitious and expand up to the Jeffcoats, Jeffcotts, etc., it didn't take long to build up 26 families which, including the confusing 'I' and 'O', exhausted the alphabet. And so, we had to have a rethink. Jess' family became 'AA', Sue and Bob's became 'AB', and so on. By December 2020, we had gone from 'AA' through to 'DZ'. After connecting many and therefore losing some codes to the archive, this added up to almost 100 family trees, for which links to others had not been found (except in a couple of instances, which will be expanded-on within the section).

To further ease the identification problem, in some cases we have added a number to the code, ie 'AA450', which enables us to build up a biography of individuals on that particular family tree, thus adding to our knowledge about individual ancestors.

The following pages are an index of the family trees that we had in 2020 and which are contained within this section. The actual list is regularly being updated, so the internet home page should be the primary source of information, not this list here.

These tables are repeated on our webpage, as the column marked 'Gedcom link' takes you to a detailed family tree that can only be accessed on the internet. These 'gedcoms' are preserved in various places for long term access and, hopefully, survivability. As of December 2020, the webpage and all the gedcoms were place on the Guild of One-Name Studies' Member's Web Page (MWP) server and the gedcoms only with FamilySearch.com, a part of the Church of Jesus Christ and Latter Day Saints.

The family codes that are underlined are those that have individual sections that we have placed in Chapter 6 of this book and which are available to view, from the webpage.

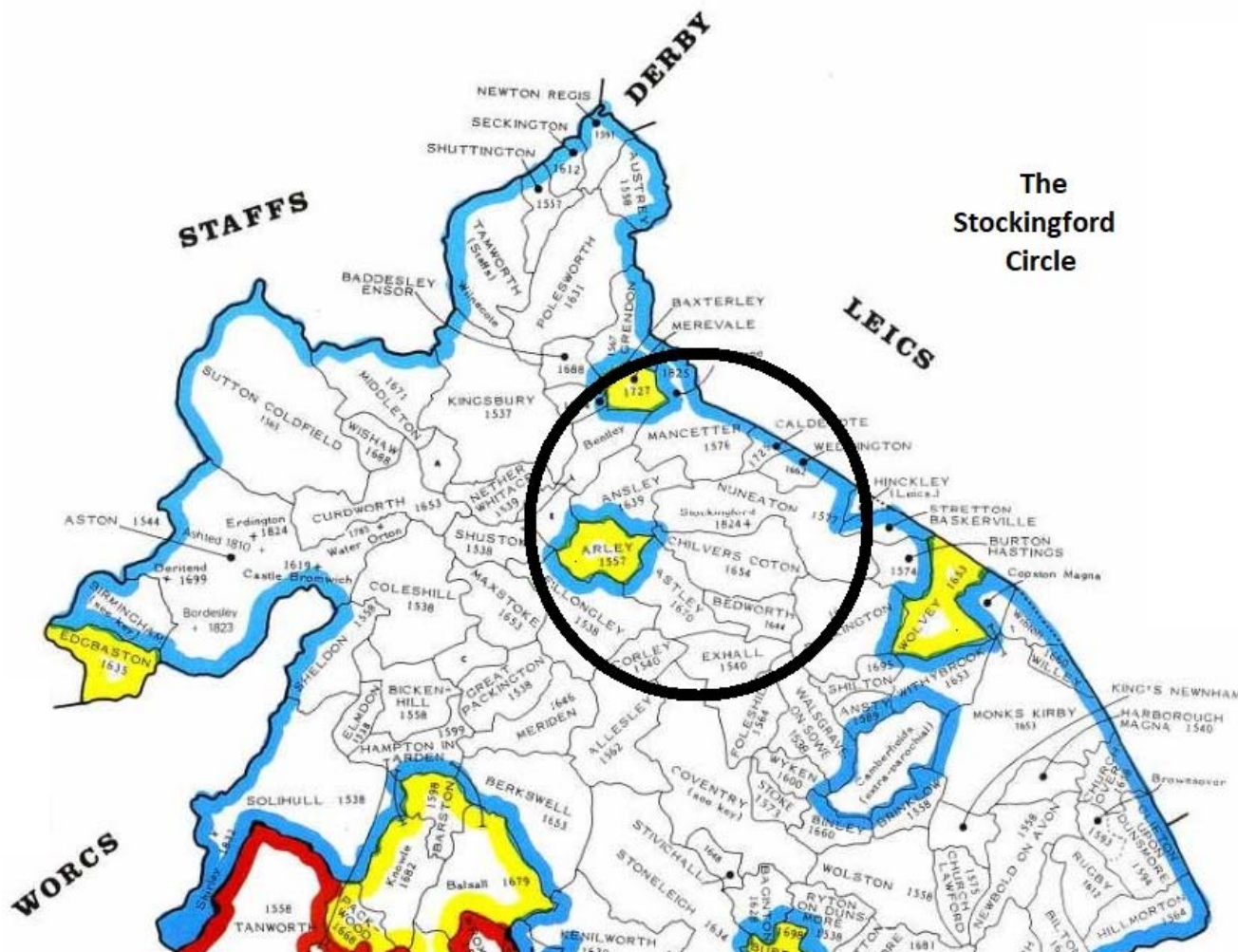

As you can see, many of the family trees have been linked to others, since they were originally constructed during our research. Thus, in December 2020, we had 77 families, 98 individual family trees, all unconnected, so far (with the exception of AA and AB, which do connect), and 6757 people included.

### The Stockingford Circle

The A, B, C and D lists of individual J families that are shown on previous pages, are full of families that come from the Stockingford Circle, in the north east corner of Warwickshire. Where you see SC in the up to date web page tables, this refers to this. We have many families from this circle of parishes.



Due to there being so many John, Thomas, William, etc. first names, it is difficult to decide who is who. All we can do is record what is clearly belonging to each branch of the family. Indeed, there is some evidence of different branches using different spellings of the name, to show some sort of separation, but, all said and done, with most of our people at that time unable to read or write, it was usually for the clerk of the church to decide what spelling he chose to use on that day.

One day we will sit down and make a closer study of the Stockingford Circle, which sees our names regularly in Nuneaton, Wrappershole, Chilvers Coton, Ansley, Arley, Stockingford, Chapel End, Robinson's End, Hartshill, etc. etc. to see whether we can separate the branches and make sense of it all.

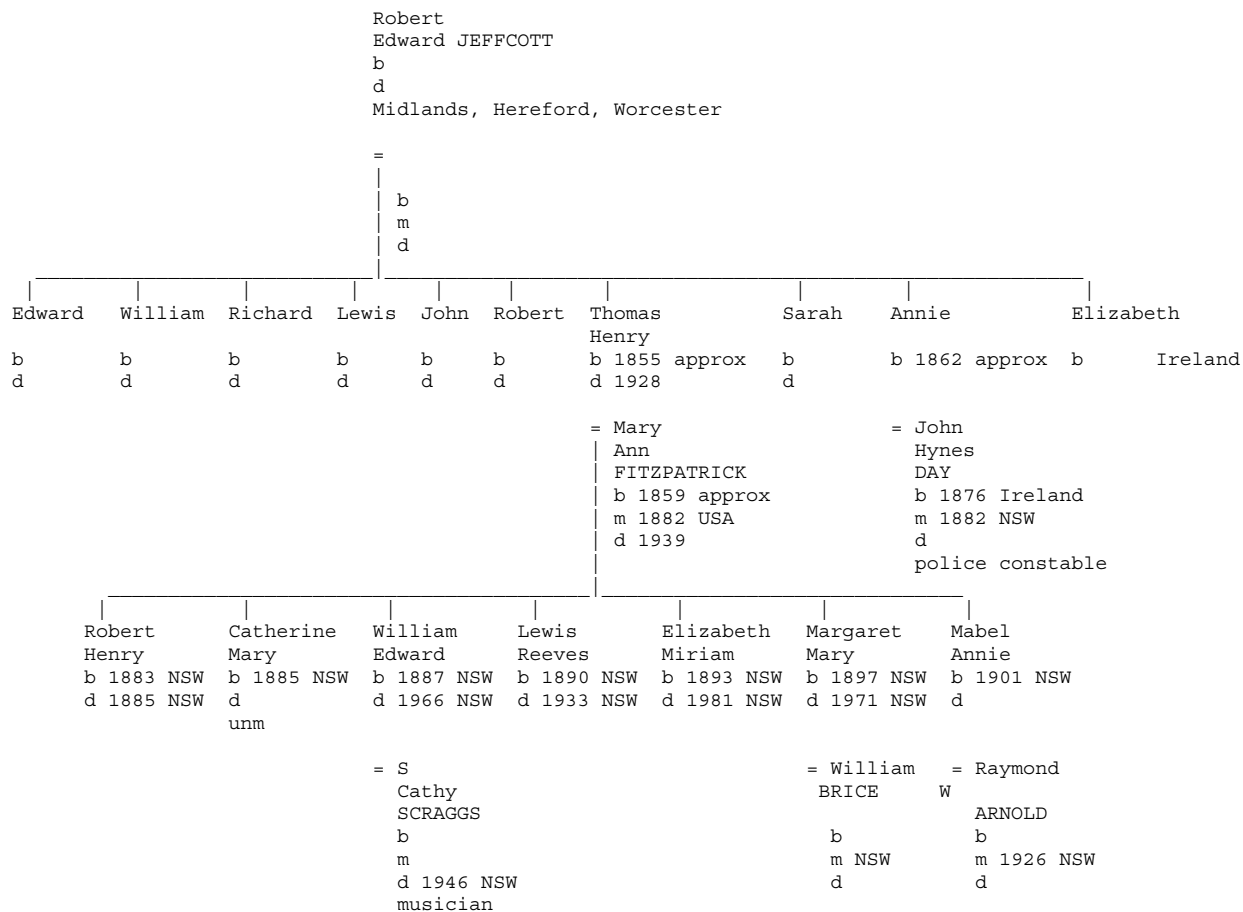
