Introduction

My brief knowledge of this family came from Mrs Bolton of Coventry. Her letter to me gave a few details and I was able to build up a family tree from my other records. I spoke to her brother on the telephone in 1982. He is a farmer in Atherstone, presumably the same land as his forefathers. However, he was not at all interested to discuss his family history, nor was Mrs Bolton, after I replied to her.

I have amongst my records, references to a John Jephcott and subsequent Jephcotts who farmed in this area and left wills and other records. I have not been able to find a link with this family, although it is probably one and the same. This is one of those families that I feel should be researched with care to avoid upset.

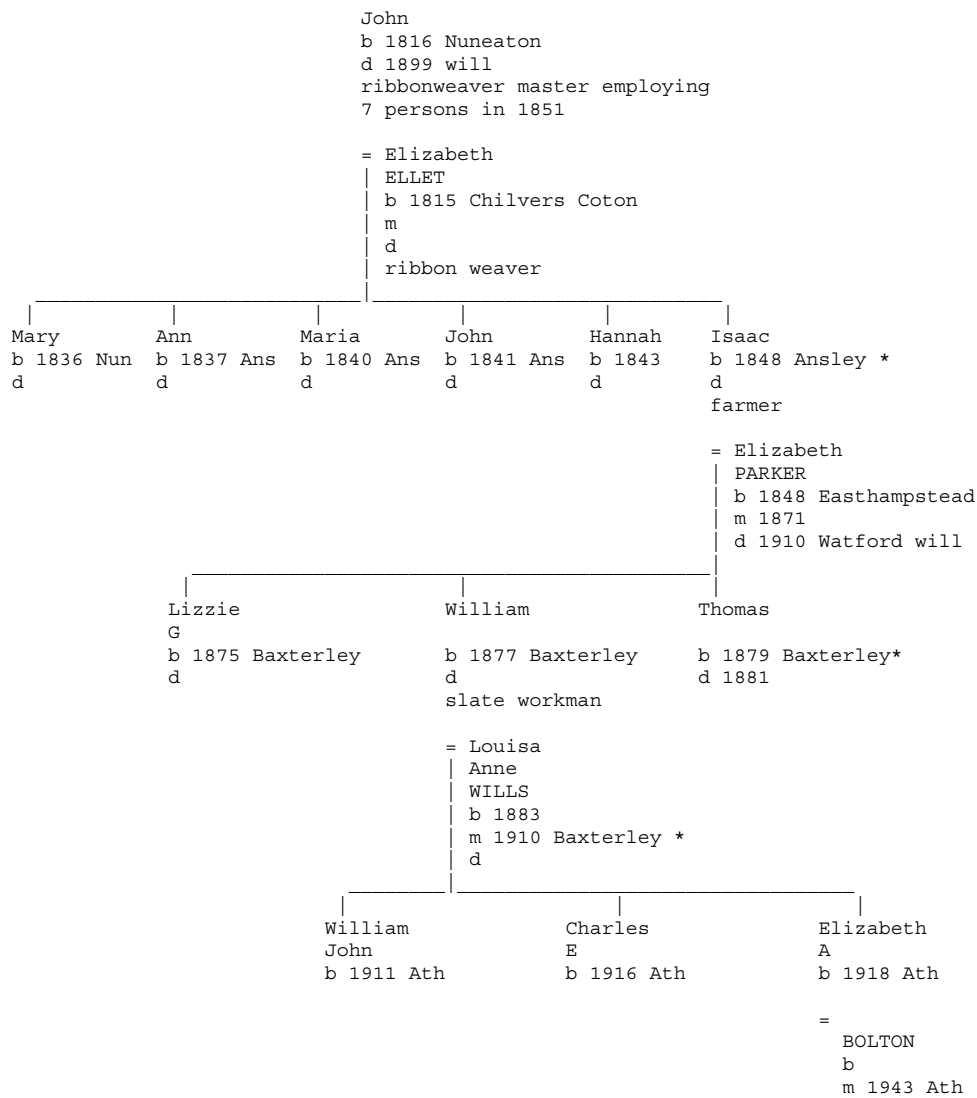
