INQUEST ADJOURNED ON EX-PIT DEPUTY

THE WIDOW of a Denaby man, who died last Friday and upon whom an inquest was opened yesterday, said in evidence that she was told 15 years ago that he could not live three months.

The man was Joseph William Dunhill Jeffcote, aged 71, of Harcourt Villa, Church Road, Denaby.

He was for many years an official at Denaby and Cadeby collieries as a deputy, overman and assistant undermanager.

He had not worked since about 1938, said Mrs. Jeffcote, and spent most of that time in bed. He got up for meals, occasionally went to the gate and went out each week to draw his pension.

She added that in 1909 he had a serious accident at Cadeby Colliery. He had a broken pelvis and was "smashed up."

They said he would not come out of hospital again, but he came out and it was then he studied and became a deputy after the Cadeby pit explosion in 1912.

Referring to his breakdown in health in 1938, the widow said he was under medical attention at Sheffield and was told not to go again because nothing more could be done for him. A local doctor told relatives that he could not live three months.

Mr. C. R. Marshall, the Coroner, remarked: "He has certainly proved them wrong."

Last Friday, it was stated, a bump was heard and Jeffcote was found lying on the bedroom floor.

The coroner explained that a post mortem examination revealed a condition which necessitated further examination and the inquest would have to be adjourned.
