#### Introduction

This family was researched by Heather Barton of Kenilworth. Her husband's great grandparents were Joseph and Sarah Jane (née Jephcote) Train.

The family tree, as we had it at the time of publishing, starts with Henry and Selina (née Spencer) Jephcote.

The 1851 census has Henry and Selina Jephcoat living at 9 Bull Street, Attleborough but with no children. Their daughter Ann appeared to have been living with the Wright family at 21 Bull Street. There are other Jephcoats in the vicinity also, but with no relationship known. The 1881 census index shows no Henry and Selina.

There was a baptism in Nuneaton for a Henry Jefcoatt to John (a collier) and Sarah, his parents, of Abbey Street, on 14th Jan 1821.

The wills index has two possible will references.

1871 W Charlotte Jefcoatt (age 79) of Nuneaton, Widow d 20.4.1871 by Henry Jefcoatt of Attleborough, Weaver, Nephew

1892 W Henry Jefcoatt (age 69) of Attleborough, Nuneaton, inn keeper d 16.11.1891

The 1851 census led to the identity of Charlotte's husband Joseph and gives them as follows:
