### The Family of Harry Jeffcoat

According to the births register, Harry Jeffcoat was born in Chapel en le Frith in Derbyshire in 1886. Normally the mother's maiden name is given. This time it is not. The 1891 census, as shown below, states that Harry was the adopted son of Sarah A Clark, aged 45 and a widow.
