Introduction

This family was discovered from an email sent by Kate Jeffcott, saying that she was the last Jeffcott of her family. Her grandfather Oliver Frank Jeffcott had passed away in 2000. His father was Frank Nelson Jeffcott, who she thought was born on Washington Island, Green Bay, Wisconsin, later moving to Alabama.

So, we looked into it and discovered five generations of the family which started with Joseph Jeffcot, born around 1780, in England, perhaps Birmingham, who his son Daniel said on Daniel's wedding certificate. That his father was a butler. Daniel too was a butler. Here is the certificate in facsimile.

Married in the *Parish Church of St. Philip's* according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Established Church, after *Reading* by me, *W. D. Jones*

This Marriage was solemnized between us, *Daniel Jeffcott* and *Sarah Ann Richardson Jones* in the Presence of us, *Anna Richardson Jones* and *Thomas Richardson* *Lecturer*

They had a son Charles H Jeffcott in England, although we can find no evidence of that, and they emigrated to the USA in 1849.

On the next page is a copy of the 1850 US census, for Van Vorst Hudson New Jersey USA. Daniel, wife Sarah and son Charles are shown, living with German neighbours. It also shows a George Jeffcott, born c1835, living with them. George turned out to Sarah's child by a previous marriage, dropping the Jeffcott name and living as Jones. All were born in England – somewhere!

Here is a story of an immigrant family making good in their new country.
